Suitable for: KS1 and SEND schools

Overview:

These videos are to help you learn the song 'Different Drums' and prepare for your final video performance.

The videos are designed to be used in sequence, beginning with 'Part 1 – Warm up' and progressing through to 'Part 7 - the final run through'.

You do not need to watch every video in one session – please do as little or as much as you feel works for your class in each session.

Adding your own actions is very much encouraged and will add to your final video performance!

Part 1 – Warm up

You should repeat 'Part 1 – Warm up' or use an alternative warm up before each singing session.

Part 2 – Learning the Chorus

Please rewind and repeat this video as much as you need to.

Part 3 – Learning the Verses

Please rewind and repeat this video as much as you need to.

Part 4 – Drums

Please choose a drum pattern to perform to begin the performance. You may use percussion instruments or body percussion.

Part 5 – Chorus Harmony

You do not need to learn the harmony parts. Please move on to part 7 if you are not singing the harmony part.

If you would like to sing the harmony parts, please choose the most suitable harmony part to sing.

Part 6 – Verse Harmony

You do not need to learn the harmony parts. Please move on to part 7 if you are not singing the harmony part.

If you would like to sing the harmony parts, please choose the most suitable harmony part to sing.

Part 7 - Run through with instrumental backing track

It is really important to keep in time with the backing track. This should be loud enough for children to hear when you are recording your final video.
