Venue?

The Instrumental Festivals will take place at Christ the Cornerstone Church, 300 Saxon Gate, Milton Keynes MK9 2ES.

Please note: You will need to submit exact attendance numbers for your school as we must comply with the capacity of the venue.

If additional children or staff come along on the day, they will not be allowed in. Please do not overestimate numbers as this may prevent another school from taking part.

Who Can Take Part?

Children who are having instrumental lessons in Primary Schools can take part.

Which instruments are included?

Ensembles of any size from 2 players upwards. String and Guitar groups on Tuesday 5 March and Woodwind and Brass groups on Wednesday 6 March.

What type of music can be performed?

Any musical performance is acceptable if there are 2 pupils or more performing. These festivals are not for solo performances. The emphasis is on inclusion and enjoyment.

With small ensembles of 2 or more, the children will often direct this themselves. For larger groups, an instrumental teacher is often required to lead the group. There will be a room for children to warm up before they perform and when they are not performing, they can enjoy listening to the other groups.

Is there a charge?

There will be a charge to schools attending of £30.00 per festival. This charge will be invoiced and is non-refundable if you withdraw or do not attend.
