Pupils must have experience of playing the keyboard already e.g. in a whole class WCET project in Year 4.

(If children don't already play the keyboard we can still offer you a keyboard project in year 5 covering basic keyboard skills and musical literacy)

Children will learn to:

- Play with both hands including chords and a melody
- Increase the fluency of their music reading
- Learn about the variety of voices available on the keyboard
- Become more creative with music allowing them to explore improvisation and composition.

Guitar Continuation Project

Price £1296 per class per year

Available to year 5 and 6 only

Pupils must have experience of playing the guitar already e.g. in a whole class WCET project in Year 4.

(If children don't already play the guitar, we can still offer you a guitar project in year 5 covering basic guitar skills)

Children will learn to:

- Play guitar using rest stroke and strumming
- Learn melodies on the guitar using the notes G A B C D E F# G
- Increase the fluency of their note reading
- Develop their creativity in improvisation and composition





