

## SEND – Help for Music Subject Leads

*'A high quality music education is the right of every pupil. It should be inclusive of all, regardless of additional needs in both mainstream and specialist settings'. (NPME 2022)*

### The Music Service can offer support to Music Subject Leaders including:

- Whole school CPD Music (subjects include the creative use of music technology; singing with confidence; using instruments in the classroom – composing, exploring and performing; listening activities; the use of resources such as 'SEND Count me In' and 'Sounds Right').
- Help and guidance with planning and disseminating skills across the school.
- Linking subject leaders with organisations and SEND music specialists

### CMPSR (Composer)

CMPSR is built to engage students who are traditionally difficult to reach and who are often excluded from Music education.

To play notes and chords, you simply move a velocity-sensitive joystick or swipe on the same colours on an iPad. This means that children have two ways of accessing the sounds – enhancing fine motor skills and increasing accessibility.

The package for SEND schools will come with iPads and controllers plus five mounts enabling wheelchair users to access the device more easily.

**SEND School Teacher delivering CMPSR project:**

**£325 (per term)**

Up to 8 CMPSR devices, 8 x iPads, 5 x Ram mounts for wheelchairs, suggested lessons plans, mini rig speakers and leads

**SEND Music Service delivering CMPSR project:**

**£425 (per term)  
(up to 10 sessions per term)**
